Numeracy Workshop for Parents/Carers

Thank you to all the parents who attended our Numeracy Workshop event on Wednesday 20th and Thursday 21st March. It was brilliant to see so many parents/carers in school, working with their children within the classroom. In total we had just under 150 parents/carers attend, and I really hope you found the experience a valuable one! We will certainly look to do similar events on an annual basis.

Premises

<u>Car Park</u> – The car park was started in the Easter holidays by Oaktree Construction. I will be having monthly progress meetings with the council and Oaktree Construction to keep an eye on the progress and any difficulties that have arisen. The estimated completion date is August, with the hope that the car park / drop-off area is fully available from 1^{st} September 2024.

I must stress the importance of using this drop-off area once complete, as I am very worried regarding an accident involving a pedestrian currently. **Please refrain from blocking the barriers and parking inconsiderately.** I know it can be very difficult, but patience is key to avoid any sort of accident.

<u>Drainage</u> – The path leading down from the field has been rectified and the surface water issue has now been resolved. I am delighted by the work carried out, and it has made a huge difference to the safety of our pupils, parents and staff members walking down from the field.

Fencing

We have had new fencing along the steps leading to the Year 1, 2 and 3 classrooms, as well as fencing at the back of the school where the nursery and reception pupils play. The fencing there is to stop pupils travelling along the steep bank and it will allow the youngest pupils to access the small grass bank. I have allocated some funds to make good the grass bank, with new topsoil and turf.

The perimeter fence had many gaps, and these have all been repaired by South Wales Fencing to ensure everyone is safe and no animals can come in.

Sports Day/Week

Sports Day will occur during the week beginning **17**th **June**. We are hoping to use our school field this year, however, we will need to ensure it is safe to use.

Sports day t-shirts will need to be worn and we will let you know what days your child will be participating in sports day.
