Car Park and Parking

We have been chasing the local authority for answers regarding the car park and I am pleased to announce it has been granted planning permission. Please see the latest statement below from the Council:

Tenders for the Abbey Primary School Car Park within the limits of Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council will be issued on Jaegger eTenderwales in the next few weeks.

The scheme is being tendered under Lot 2c and 3 of the SWWRCECF and is estimated to be worth circa which is close to the lot thresholds. The programme will commence in March 2024 and be fully complete by August 2024.

Provisionally, submission will be on 9th February 2024 at midday;

So, pleasing news that the project will be started in March 2024. It should be completed by the end of the summer 2024. Let's hope it is sooner!

That being said, it still does not eradicate the issues we have currently with parking. So, please can I remind you all to:

- Park in designated parking bays. Please do not park on grass verges, or pavements.
- DO NOT block/park in front of barriers.

- Ensure you walk around the school site using the footpaths and not through the traffic.
