Premises and Site Safety

Car Park/Drop-off Zone

I am pleased to say that the new car park/drop-off zone is working brilliantly with nearly all parents/family members abiding by the rules and parking appropriately. There are still a minority of parents/carers who are parking on the double yellow lines (particularly when I am not there monitoring). PLEASE DO NOT PARK INCONSIDERATELY.

There have also been a few occasions where parents/carers/grandparents have been very rude to our Site Managers, Paul and Jeff. If I hear of anyone swearing or being obnoxious to my staff, I will be taking a zero-tolerance approach and seeking advice from our legal team. There is absolutely no need for people to be rude to one another. Please can we all be kind and considerate, as all we want is for everyone to be safe.

The final piece of the car park/drop-off zone jigsaws are nearly complete. A **barrier** will be installed soon where the blue dividers are currently. This will be down during peak times (8:30am to 9am and 3pm to 3:30pm). We will also be having bollards installed to prevent cars parking where pedestrians are walking. Once these jobs are finished, the snag list is completed. We are extremely fortunate to have such a brilliant facility for our school. It has made the parking situation so much safer, and I am sure residents are also much happier. Thank you to the families who are using the facility properly and safely.
