#### Punctuality & Attendance

#### Premises

#### Car Park/Drop-off Zone

I am pleased to say that the new car park/drop-off zone is nearly complete. It will be completed and operational from <u>Monday 4<sup>th</sup> November</u>. Please be reminded that there will now be additional double-yellow lines, and the camera car will be around to ensure parents/carers are using the drop-off zone and car park correctly.

The **barrier** is now the only concern we have remaining. The 'in' barrier for the school staff car park needs to be moved so that children and parents can safely cross from the new drop-off zone/car park to the footpath. This barrier will be moved within the next 6 weeks, so in the meantime, a temporary barrier will be in place.

The main gates will be open as usual, with a temporary barrier placed just before the current three barriers. **NO ACCESS** past the barrier will occur between **8:30am and 9am or 3pm to 3:30pm**.

THE SAFETY OF ALL PEDESTRIANS IS THE MOST IMPORTANT ASPECT AND I URGE YOU ALL TO RESPECT THE RULES, PARK SENSIBLY IN LINE WITH THE LAW AND TO USE OUR BRAND-NEW CAR PARK/DROP-OFF ZONE! Failure to comply with the new rules will result in the MAIN GATES being locked between the above times. That way, everyone must use the new car park/drop-off zone, and I have met the local authority this morning and they are in full agreement with this.

#### UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD PARENTS PARK IN FRONT OF THE BARRIERS.

**Complaints** – I have received a number of complaints over the course of the past 12 months regarding parents/carers being abusive towards residents, parking inconsiderately and also being aggressive, all with children near by or in their presence.

Please can I politely remind all parents/carers to be respectful to our community members and ensure we live and work in harmony. I appreciate the difficulty parking, but we are very fortunate to have this new car park/drop-off zone, and I sincerely hope this alleviates the pressure in the surrounding area.

I am also aware of residents being rude to parents/carers and children...so hopefully, this new facility eases all the stress of parking! If you are every verbally abused by residents, please report it to the police.
